The MRT is Taiwan's subway train. MRT stands for Mass Rapid **Transit**. The trains run under the ground. Taipei has the biggest MRT system. Kaohsiung also has one.

The MRT is very **clean**. There are rules to follow. You cannot eat or drink on the train. If you do, you will pay a **fine**. People keep the MRT nice for everyone.

Riding the MRT is easy. You use a card called an EasyCard. Just **tap** the card when you enter and exit. The card takes the money **automatically**. You can add more money at machines.

The trains come very often. You only wait a few **minutes**. Each train line has a color like red, blue, or green. Signs help you find the right **platform**. It is hard to get lost.

Millions of people use the MRT every day. It is faster than taking a bus or car. There is no **traffic**. The MRT helps make Taiwan a great place to live and visit!
