## Past Tense — Quick Rules

| Type                 | Rule   | Examples   |
|----------------------|--|--|
| Regular              | + <b>-ed</b>   ends -e: + <b>-d</b>   consonant+y: <b>y → ied</b>   short vowel+consonant: double + <b>-ed</b> | walk → walked care → cared try → tried<br>stop → stopped |
| Negative / Irregular | didn't + base verb   Different form — memorise   | She didn't go.   see → saw go → went<br>know → knew      |

## Future Tense — Quick Rules

| Form            | Structure                                       | Use                                       | Example                                      |
|-----------------|---|---|--|
| <b>will</b>     | Subject + <b>will</b> + base verb               | Spontaneous decision / general prediction | I <u>will help</u> you now.                  |
| <b>going to</b> | Subject + <b>am/is/are going to</b> + base verb | Pre-made plan / evidence-based prediction | She <u>is going to travel</u> — bags packed. |

- A: "The phone is ringing." B: "I ( **will answer** / **am going to answer** ) it!" → *spontaneous decision*
- She already bought her ticket. She ( **will fly** / **is going to fly** ) to London. → *plan already made*
- I think robots ( **will replace** / **are going to replace** ) many jobs. → *general prediction*
- Watch out! That cyclist ( **will fall** / **is going to fall** ) — the road is icy! → *evidence-based*
- Don't worry, I ( **will cook** / **am going to cook** ) something for everyone. → *on-the-spot decision*

**Remember:** *will* = spontaneous decision / general prediction. *going to* = pre-made plan / visible evidence.
