Notes on Open-Answer Questions (for teacher discretion — accept reasonable variations)

Q11: Not only is my teacher strict, but she is also very fair and kind.

(Also accept: "My teacher is not only strict but also very fair and kind.")

Q16: Although / Though he was very tired, he still helped his mother clean the house.

(Also accept "though" at the end: "He was very tired, though he still helped...")

Q21: If you eat too much junk food, you will feel sick.

(Accept any grammatically correct first conditional sentence on this theme.)

Q25: He ended up getting fired / He ended up losing his job.

(Accept any clear "ended up + verb-ing" answer that reflects the original meaning.)
