



Chocolate — A Sweet Treat from a Tree

Chocolate is one of the most **popular** foods in the whole world. It is soft, **brown**, and very **sweet**. Almost everyone loves to eat it! People enjoy chocolate in candy bars, cakes, cookies, and warm drinks. But do you know where this yummy treat comes from? At first, it does not come from a store. It comes from a plant!

Chocolate begins on a **tree** called the cacao tree. This **tree** likes to **grow** in hot, wet places near the middle of the Earth. On the tree are big fruits called pods. Inside each pod are many seeds. We call these seeds cacao **beans**. Each **bean** is small, but it holds the special **taste** of chocolate.

First, farmers pick the pods and take out the **beans**. The **beans** dry in the warm sun. Then trucks take them to a big **factory**. At the **factory**, machines clean the beans and turn them into chocolate. Workers add **sugar** to make it sweeter. Sometimes they add **milk**, too. This makes soft, creamy milk chocolate.

There are different kinds of chocolate. Dark chocolate has lots of cacao and only a little **sugar**. **Milk** chocolate has more **milk** and tastes very **sweet**. White chocolate is not really **brown** at all! People all around the world **taste** these different kinds and pick their favorite.

Long ago, people did not eat chocolate. They drank it as a bitter drink! Today, chocolate is a **popular** treat that makes many people happy. So the next time you eat a piece of **sweet** chocolate, remember its long trip — from a tiny **bean** on a **tree** to the candy in your hand.
