



Eagles — Kings of the Sky

An eagle is a large **bird** that lives near the **sky**. It has a big, curved beak and two wide wings. Eagles can be brown, black, white, or gold. A bald eagle has a white head and a bright yellow beak. It is one of the most beautiful **birds** in the world.

Eagles can **fly** very **high** — sometimes as high as a mountain! They have **large** wings that help them soar through the air for a long time. They do not need to flap their wings very often. They use warm air rising from the ground to glide and float without getting tired.

Eagles eat **food** like fish, rabbits, and small animals. When they spot something to eat, they **fly** down super **fast** to catch it with their strong feet and sharp claws. A diving eagle can move faster than a speeding car. They are some of the best hunters in the animal world.

An eagle has the best **eye** of any animal on Earth. It can see eight times better than a person! An eagle sitting on top of a tall tree can spot a tiny rabbit far away on the ground below. Its **sharp** eyes help it find **food** before any other animal even notices.

Eagles build their homes, called nests, at the very top of tall trees or **high** on rocky cliffs. A nest can grow as big as a car over many years! Eagles are **strong** and brave animals. People all around the world call them the kings of the sky — and it is easy to see why.
