A tiger is one of the biggest **wild** cats in the world. It has orange fur with black **stripes** all over its **body**. No two tigers have the same stripes — just like no two people have the same fingerprints. Tigers are very strong and beautiful animals.

Most tigers live in the **forest** in Asia. They like to be near rivers and lakes. The trees help tigers hide from other animals. Tigers are very good at staying still and quiet so other animals cannot see them coming.

Tigers love to **eat** meat. They **hunt** animals like deer and wild pigs. A tiger can walk very quietly. It sneaks up close, then **runs** fast and jumps onto its food. Tigers are some of the fastest runners in the animal world.

Tigers have large, bright **eyes** that can see very well, even at **night**. This helps them find food in the dark. Tiger mothers take good care of their **baby** cubs for about two years. Baby cubs learn to hunt by watching their mother.

Today, there are not many tigers left in the world. People cut down forests and build on tiger land. This makes it hard for tigers to stay **safe**. We must protect tigers and their homes so these big and beautiful wild cats can live for many more years.

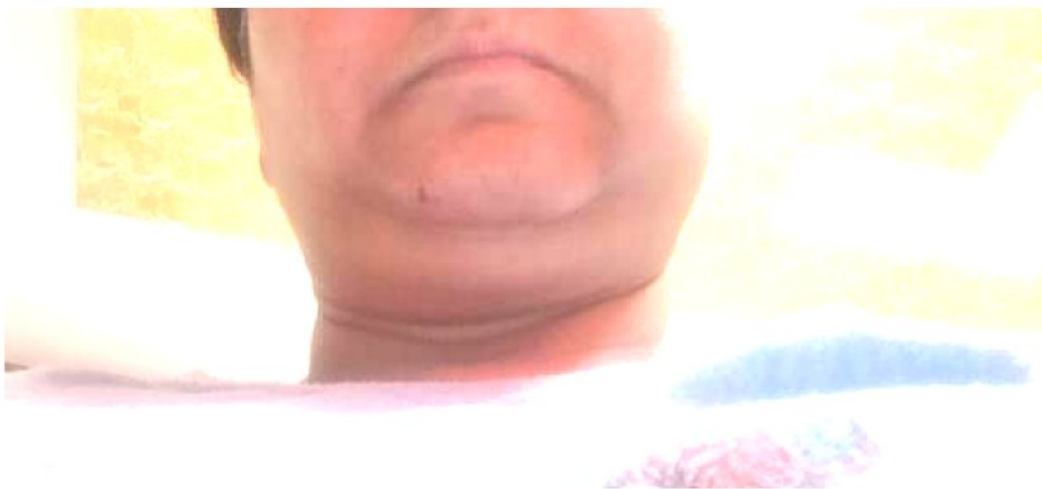
